We are delighted to announce that our Eco Team has successfully led the school to achieve the prestigious Eco-Schools Green Flag Award, with Distinction.

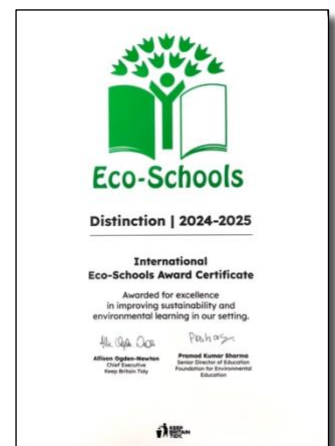
What is the Green Flag Award?
