Enrichment at Bagthorpe



At Bagthorpe Primary School, we want our children to flourish. We want them to:

- **learn** for life, developing independence
- **grow** together, developing confidence
- **achieve** their best, developing resilience

We place a strong emphasis on providing access to a wide range of experiences, activities and opportunities both within and beyond the curriculum, that will enhance children's learning and enrich their lives.

The range of enrichment and wider curriculum opportunities provided may vary according to the children's year group, season (particularly in the area of sport) capacity to deliver and demand. Some extra-curricular clubs run for a fixed number of weeks. Some clubs are in response to request from children.

Enrichment and wider curriculum opportunities currently on offer are shown in the table opposite, where they are grouped into best-fit categories.

We map provision from EYFS to Year 6 and are improving how we track uptake, to make sure that key children and vulnerable groups can be targeted.
