Intent

Our PSHE curriculum is underpinned by our [School Aims & Core Values](#) of Moral Purpose, Humility, Compassion, Integrity, Accountability, Courage and Determination as well as those of Transform Trust: Respect, Kindness, Equity and Creativity

We aim to make our school a happy place where we all **learn** for life, **grow** together and work hard to **achieve** our personal best, in an environment where every person matters.

This is also captured within our motto: **learn, grow, achieve**. We want **all** our children to:

Implementation

- At Bagthorpe Primary School we use the Coram Life Education SCARF Curriculum. SCARF stands for: Safety, Caring, Achievement, Resilience & Friendship. This values-based approach fits readily with our intent, above.
- **SCARF lessons** promote positive behaviour, mental health, wellbeing, resilience, and achievement.
- Lesson plans are mapped to the **National Curriculum**, covering the DfE statutory requirements for [Relationships and Sex Education \(RSE\) and Health Education](#) and the [PSHE Association's Programme of Study](#) recommended learning opportunities
- We supplement PSHE learning within our annual **assembly planner and programme of school visitors**, incorporating Anti-Bullying Week, Children's Mental Health Week, Healthy School Week, and Safer Internet Day.
- SCARF is a **spiral curriculum**, meaning children cover the same six themes each year, and each time they a theme 'comes around' the complexity increases, reinforcing previous learning. This is how we build upon, deepen and reinforce children's knowledge.
